The general public is invited to join Texas Parks & Wildlife and the Ozona Chamber of Commerce & Visitor Center to celebrate the launching of a new Heart of Texas West map. The Heart of Texas West Map stretches north from San Angelo down south to Del Rio, west from Ozona and east into the Texas Hill Country. Included in the map are 12 separate loops, or trails, each of which encompasses an array of wildlife, nature and birding sites. It is one of nine maps in the Great Texas Wildlife Trails Program. These wildlife and birding maps will guide you to the best nature viewing spots in the state, and provide detailed instructions on how to reach each site and GPS coordinates where available.

Following a formal announcement at 1:30 p.m. to unveil the map, guests will have from 2:00-5:00 p.m. to visit exhibits and displays of attractions in Crockett and surrounding counties. Admission is free.

Come on out and discover where you can travel to see caverns, study history, learn about bats, birds and nature. For the more adventurous, find out where you can go off-roading, star gazing, take hikes, mountain bike riding, hunting, and much more.....
